### **Pick Up Date:**

- Sunday, March 22nd (subject to change due to weather, bee buildup, etc.)

### **Pick Up Location & Time:**

- Williamsburg: [Jamestown Feed and Seed](#)
  - 9:30 – 11:30 – package pick up
  - **9:00 – *Package Installation Demonstration***
    - Note: Jamestown Feed & Seed is open especially for our honey bee pick up this day. The store itself will be closed.
- Suffolk: [Deer Forest Road](#) (Luning Farm)
  - 10:30 – 11:30 – package pick up

### **Parking:**

- **Williamsburg:** See the map below for parking at [Jamestown Feed and Seed](#). Please be careful when parking, it can be tight; be considerate of your fellow beekeepers!
- **Suffolk:** Proceed up the driveway. It is narrow, so please alternative vehicles entering and leaving.

### **How to Bring Your Bees Home:**

- The package will be gently brushed to remove bees, but there may be a straggler or two on the cage. You can place the package in your car (air-conditioned), trunk or in the back of a truck FOR TRANSPORT ONLY. Once you reach your destination the package must be stored per below. How you transport them is a personal decision, but remember to give them plenty of ventilation and do not overheat the bees.

### **How to Store Your Package:**

- If you need to store your package of bees for a while you can keep them in your cool garage. Make sure the bees are not exposed to excessive heat or cold, loud noise, or unusual vibrations. You do not need to spray the bees with sugar syrup (1 part sugar, 1 part water), though some people choose to. The bees have a can of sugar water with them in the cage and it is all they really need for a few days.
- DO NOT: Put the cage in the hive to store them; store them on a porch or other area exposed to direct sunlight; store them where animals may disturb them!

### **Other Useful Info:**

- Time of day to install your package: I suggest waiting until dusk, though this is a personal choice. People install packages at all times of the day.
